



## How to Create a Triple Layer Dragonfly



Sue Wilson's latest release of dies includes a new collection – **The Triple Layer Collection**. I thought it would be useful to show you step by step how to create a Triple Layer Dragonfly – the other dies in the collection can be used with the same method.

There are 3 dies in the Dragonfly set. To make it easier to show you, I've given the dies a number, top to bottom. You can see here how they all look when cut out. Dies 1 and 2 have no outside cutting edge.



**Step 1**  
Glue die cut 1 on top of die cut 2.



**Step 2**  
Secure die 3 over the top using Low Tack Tape and cut.



**Step 3**  
So, this is how 2 layers look – you could use it just like this.



**Step 4**  
Glue to die cut 3 and you have your triple layer.



**Step 5**  
Shape the wings of the dragonfly whilst the glue is still wet and they will keep their shape better.



A very versatile die set that can be used as a single layer, a double layer and a triple layer.
